Germany's Yomei set to inspire with stunning yet versatile furniture

What does a make-up table have in common with a bar cabinet and an office workstation? German furniture designer André Schelbach, creative director of furniture manufacturer Yomei, will be answering this question by displaying his unique 'Magic Cube' at the Index show in Dubai.



Schelbach has already caused a sensation at the imm Cologne 2008 show with his decorative leather pieces from the Yomei range and the 'Magic Desk', an innovative interpretation of the classic secretary in leather.

Now Schelbach and his team have now come up with another show-stopping design for the Index exhibition in December – the 'Magic Cube'. The new piece offers three different distinct benefits from a single design. The outwardly straightforward

cabinet can be converted from the inside into a make-up/dressing table, a coffee/bar cabinet or a computer/office centre.

All three designs have a surprising array of features: the make-up table has a light-up rear view mirror, numerous drawers, cosmetic mirror with 5x magnification and integrated power outlet for hairdryer or electric shaver; the bar cabinet has an illuminated rear view mirror, refrigerator, additional
